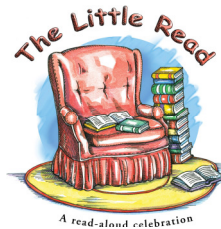
A Day with Firefighters by Jan Kottke Describes what firefighters wear, the equipment they use, and how they fight fires. **JET KOT***

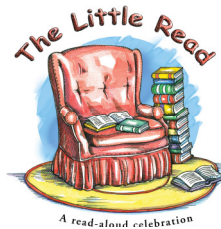

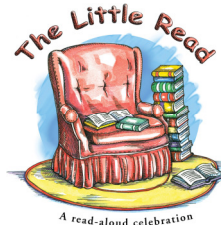
