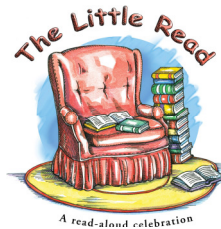

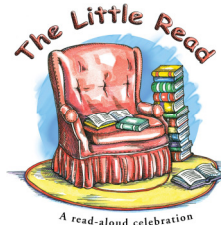

***Moon Plane*** by Peter McCarty A young boy looks at a plane in the sky and imagines flying one all the way to the moon. **JE MCC\***

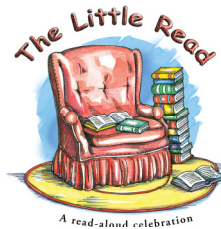
***Mooncake*** by Frank Asch Bear builds a rocket to take him to the moon so he can taste it. **JE ASC\***

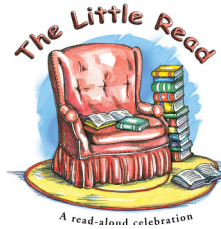
***Space Case*** by Edward Marshall When the thing from outer space visits Earth, it is taken first for a trick-or-treater and then for a robot. **JE MAR\***
